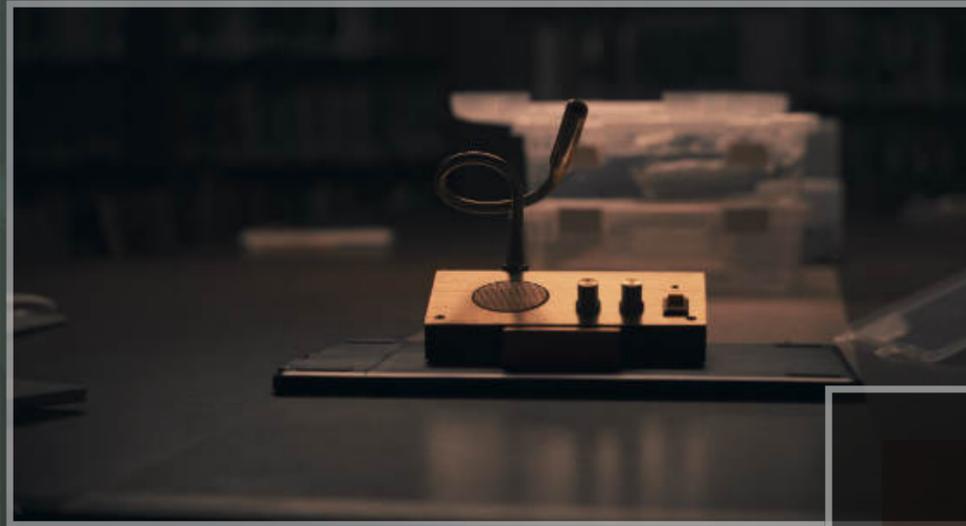

Director's Statement

'Wattleseed' at the center of the film exists as a force the characters project their anxieties onto, and whether the AI ever truly does anything is left ambiguous for the audience to sit with. At its simplest, it's about a man who convinces himself that engineering a tragedy is the same thing as preventing one.

The warnings Adrian and Leo raise about AI misregulation are real and worth taking seriously, but the film is more interested in questioning what happens when conviction quietly becomes its own justification.
